## Baltimore County Public Schools Dundalk/Sollers Point High School Complex

The new Dundalk/Sollers Point High School complex is a \$78 million 365,307 square-foot facility with two separate high schools sharing common core facilities on the existing Dundalk High School site. Dundalk is a comprehensive high school while Sollers Point is a career and technical school. The high school complex is the single largest project undertaken by Baltimore County Public Schools. Dundalk High School accommodates 1,226 students and Sollers Point Technical 722 students for a combined size of 300,265 square feet. A major feature of the building is the atrium which contains the café space of the Sollers Culinary Arts program and the shared Media Center. The school opened in August 2014.
