## What's New

### Crofton High School

ESP recently entered into a contract with GWWO Architects to work on the schematic design for the new Crofton High School in Crofton, MD. The school will be a 271,800 square foot facility designed to educate over 1,600 students, and will feature extensive use of classroom technology. ESP will be providing technology planning and IT communications infrastructure design services for the \$125 million building.



### Trenton High School

ESP is currently providing technology planning and telecommunications infrastructure design for the new Trenton High School in New Jersey. ESP is working with DIGroupArchitecture to design voice, video, AV, data, and security layouts for the 350,000 square foot structure. The \$139,000,000 high school is designed to educate 1,850 students and will feature advanced classroom technology throughout the building.



### Patterson-Claremont High School

ESP has been engaged to provide IT services for the new Patterson Claremont School in Baltimore City. The project features work on a 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade high school, a career and technology program, and the Claremont Special Education Facility. The approximately \$65 million school will equip Baltimore City students with the tools to acquire an excellent education and the skills to thrive in the adult world.



## Dulaney and Woodlawn High Schools

ESP is currently providing IT design work as part of \$30 million renovations to Dulaney High School and Woodlawn High Schools in Baltimore County. The ESP's designs will help bring these outdated facilities into the 21<sup>st</sup> century through upgrades to the schools' intercom, telephone, security, and cabling systems. These improvements will provide students with a safer and more effective learning environment.



## Orr Elementary School

Educational Systems Planning has been engaged to offer IT, AV, and security consulting services for the new Orr Elementary School in Washington, D.C. Working with Cox, Graae, & Spack Architects, ESP will provide the students of Orr Elementary with an educational facility that makes the most of the 21<sup>st</sup> century digital technologies that today's young people are already familiar with.
